

LOS ANGELES PRINTMAKING SOCIETY NEW MEMBER APPLICATION SPRING 2007

The Los Angeles Printmaking Society invites printmakers to apply for membership to the society. Applicants will be juried by distinguished members of the art community. Applicants may submit either original work or slides.

Applicants should submit _____:

Portfolios: A portfolio of six prints made in the last two years, at least two of which must be a traditional and editionable printmaking process, such as etching, woodcut, lithography, etc. Please indicate the process used for each piece. Works need not be matted, but should be protected. The LAPS will NOT accept framed work and assumes no responsibility for loss or damaged works from any cause. Artists may wish to carry their own insurance.

Slides: Slides of six prints made in the last two years, at least two of which must be a traditional and editionable printmaking process, such as etching, woodcut, lithography, etc. Each slide should be clearly labelled with the artist name, title, medium, dimensions and date of execution. A self-addressed stamped enveloped must be included if you wish to have your slides returned.

Local applicants may drop off their application materials at Josephine Press from 2-6pm on Friday, June 1st and pick up their portfolios on Saturday, June 2nd from 2-6pm.

Out of town applicants may mail their portfolio in a reusable carton and must include return postage. Mailed application materials must arrive at Josephine Press by Thursday, May 31st. Materials arriving after this date can not be considered for review.

All applications should include a \$50.00 check made out to the LAPS for membership fees.
This will be returned in the event of non-acceptance.

Printmakers applying are also encouraged to submit a CD with jpegs of six prints for inclusion in our member on-line gallery. Each jpeg should be 72 dpi and no larger than 800 pixels in any direction. A word file should be included with title, size, media, and date information for each piece, a 50 word artist statement and biography may be included as well. This is for inclusion in the on-line gallery ONLY and not for jurying.
